Says Chan, "Initially, we were a little concerned [about the use of dark colours], but we visited the site and realised that the interior was very bright, mainly because of the full-height sliding glass windows throughout the home."

Instead of simply using paint to achieve the desired dark hues, the team opted for a more interesting and sophisticated option: Overlaying the custom-built wall treatment with dark walnut wall panelling.

## **Putting On The Finishing Touches**

Having put in place this elegant backdrop, no less attention was paid to furnishing the home with specially sourced or built design accents.

An imposing off-white sofa by Minotti – a favourite brand of the homeowners, who also use the brand in their home in Los Angeles – anchors the living room area.
